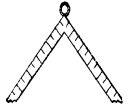

Proposed By-Law Change

Current By-Law reads as follows:

Article I

Lodge Meetings

Section 1: This Lodge shall hold Stated Communications monthly, on the Thursday on or next preceding each full of the moon at 7:30 PM.

Amend Section 1 to read as follows:

Article I

Lodge Meetings

Section 1: This Lodge shall hold Stated Communications monthly, on the Thursday on or next preceding each full of the moon at 7:30 PM with the exception of holidays. In the event that a Stated Meeting falls on a holiday, the Stated Meeting will be held on the preceding Thursday. The Annual Meeting shall be held on the 2nd Thursday in December of each year.

Purpose:

Under the current bylaws, if a Tyrian Lodge's Stated Communication falls on a holiday, (such as Thanksgiving, Christmas, etc.), typically only 2-3 people attend, which is not enough to conduct business. The purpose of the above bylaw change is to allow the Lodge to encourage

more attendance at meetings when the date of the Stated Meeting falls on a holiday. This change moves the stated meeting to the week before the holiday.

As an example; this year, the Stated Meeting is scheduled to fall on November 26, 2009 (Thanksgiving Day). The bylaw change would move the Stated Meeting to November 19, 2009 (the Thursday before). This allows the Lodge to fully conduct its meeting for November, and to allow the members to enjoy the holiday without having to leave their families to conduct Lodge business.

Also, later this year, the Annual Meeting (December's Stated Meeting) will fall on December 31, 2009 (New Year's Eve) This is an important meeting for the Lodge, as it contains all of the annual reports and election of officers for the following year. To allow the members to enjoy the holidays with their families, and to encourage attendance at the Annual Meeting, the meeting day for December would be fixed to the 2nd Thursday of that month only. This would move the Annual Meeting this year from December 31, 2009 to December 17, 2009.

For the remainder of the Lodge year, the Lodge would continue to meet as it usually does, which is on the Thursday on or before the Full of the Moon at 7:30 PM. The only month that will have a fixed meeting day would be in the month of December (2nd Thursday).
