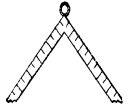

## Tyrian Lodge #73 A.F. & A.M. From the East



Greetings Brethren:

Spring is finally here, and the temperatures are rising. Time to start cleaning up the yard, fire up the barbeque, and enjoy the summer with your family and your Lodge.

We had an active month, once again, at the Lodge during May, with Stated Meeting on May 7<sup>th</sup>, a double Fellowcraft Degree on May 21<sup>st</sup> for our annual inspection, and a double Entered Apprentice Degree the following night. We anticipate rounding out the month with our second Master Mason degree on May 28<sup>th</sup>.

The summer will continue to be active. Though we officially go dark in July and August, we will continue degree work due to the large number of candidates we are processing. Currently, we have three in need of an Entered Apprentice Degree, and four in need of their Fellowcraft Degree. We have also continued to receive petitions, and the Lodge is more active than we have been in a long time. This is great news for our Lodge and for our fraternity.

Coming up in June we have a Stated Meeting scheduled for June 4<sup>th</sup>, which will include an Entered Apprentice Degree. On June 11<sup>th</sup>, I have scheduled a Fellowcraft Degree, and there will most likely be a degree on June 25<sup>th</sup> as well.

The deadline has now passed for the Night at the Seadogs on July 11<sup>th</sup>. Unfortunately, only 6 brethren and their families have decided to come to the event. Tickets will be distributed toward the end of June to those who have reserved a seat.

One exciting event has been scheduled for October 3, 2009, and that is the "Battle of the Craft.;" a new event that pits one Lodge vs. another in a friendly ritualistic competition. Tyrian Lodge has been challenged by Webster Lodge in Wales, and will be the first two Lodges in the Jurisdiction to compete in this event. The competition will involve the officers of each Lodge conducting a degree (to be determined). One will be held before supper, and the other held afterward. The winning Lodge will have bragging rights, and will win an award. Other Lodges can then challenge the winning Lodge to obtain the trophy. It should be a lot of fun! I encourage each of the officers to mark this on their calendars and to start practicing their parts for all three degrees. The event will be held in Auburn, so there will be plenty of room to watch and see your Lodge officers perform. My goal as Master is to come home with the trophy!
